

DARTMOUTH GENERAL HOSPITAL AUXILIARY STUDENT BURSARY GUIDELINES

1. The bursary shall be known as “The Dartmouth General Hospital Auxiliary Bursary”.
2. The bursary shall be presented annually provided there are suitable applicants
3. The bursary will be given to a deserving student entering a health profession (e.g. physician, registered nurse, certified nursing assistant, pharmacist, paramedic, laboratory technician, medical records, radiological technician, respiratory therapist, etc.)
4. The recipient shall be a resident of Dartmouth or immediate area.
5. In the event of a tie, priority will be given to a family member of a current Dartmouth General Hospital Auxiliary member and volunteering in a health care environment and meeting all requirements of the Guidelines.
6. Good academic standing is a prerequisite.
7. The amount of the bursary shall be \$1,500.00
8. Application forms will be distributed to Student Services Departments at Dartmouth High School, Prince Andrew High School, Auburn Drive High School, Cole Harbour District High School and Ecole du Carrefour in April of each year. Completed applications must be received by May 15th.
9. A committee shall be established each year consisting of a chairperson and two other members of the DGH Auxiliary to distribute and receive applications, review applications, and recommend the potential recipient to the executive committee of the Auxiliary
10. Upon ratification of the executive committee, the Student Services Department of the winning school will be advised in writing. The successful applicant will be advised at his/her graduation ceremony.
11. After submitting confirmation of enrollment in September, the bursary cheque of \$1,500.00 will be given to successful applicant.
12. The Student Services Departments of the five high schools will be notified of the successful candidate.
